New Hyde Park Special Park District Survey For the Renovation of the Clinton G. Martin Park Pool Facility

The Clinton G. Martin Park Pool facility is 50 years old and the infrastructure is in dire need of replacement in order for it to stay open beyond the 2016 summer season. There are two options we can take to assure that the pool stays open and remains an active part of the community. In both options, the footprint of the main pool remains the same, including all swim lanes.

Plan 1 would include replacing only the infrastructure of the pool and its internal components (pumps, filters, etc.). This option would not change the appearance of the pool facility.

Plan 2 would include replacing the infrastructure and would also redesign the entire facility, adding many amenities such as locker room improvements, doubling the shade area, façade renovations, spray features and a recreation room for park district residents only.

As a resident of the New Hyde Park Special Park District your taxes will be impacted by either decision regarding the proposed renovations to the pool. If residents choose to not do upgrades (**Plan 3**), the pool will have to be closed indefinitely.

This is not a project that the Town is planning without your input. We have been working closely with the New Hyde Park Special Park District Advisory Committee and now we want to hear what YOU think. As residents of the Park District, you are all shareholders of this project as your taxes operate the pool.

We understand that it will be your money that will be spent on this project, and we do not take that lightly. We are very eager to learn what you think should be included in this project and what you envision for the pool. We would appreciate you filling out the survey below.
