Eligibility

To be eligible for consideration, the submission must be an original work, made by a student or group of students living or attending school in the Town of North Hempstead. One submission per student or group will be permitted.

Requirements

Entries must use primarily reclaimed or recycled content (NO GLASS). Use of new or unused materials in large amounts, or in ways that are central to the theme of the piece may render artworks ineligible for award or display.

Each piece must be submitted on a hanger, and accompanied by a fully completed Entry and Release form (including name, grade, school, materials, brief description, and title). The entry form, release and consent by a parent / guardian of each student must accompany each submission. Failure to submit an entry form or general release will bar consideration. Participants will be notified of the appropriate time to pick up the pieces, after which time they become the property of The Town of North Hempstead.

Review Criteria

Entries will be judged by the North Hempstead Arts Advisory Committee, based on relevance to the theme, originality, recycled materials used, appeal, execution, and persuasiveness. The determination of the committee is final and shall not be reviewed.
