Councilwoman De Giorgio offered the following resolution and moved its adoption, which resolution was declared adopted after a poll of the members of this Board:

RESOLUTION NO. 459 -2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A BID FOR AN AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE READING SYSTEM (TNH140-2016).

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Administrative Services (the "Commissioner") solicited bids for an automated license plate reading system ("ALPR System") (TNH140-2016); and

WHEREAS, bids were received as forth in Exhibit A attached hereto (the "Bids"); and

WHEREAS, following a review of the Bids, it was found that the apparent low bidder, SecureWatch24, was primarily a provider of video surveillance and only has experience with implementing an ALPR System as a reseller of a system provided by another company known as Genetec; and

WHEREAS, seamless integration between the equipment used to provide an LPR function and the Town's parking enforcement software is paramount to providing a close to error-free solution for parking enforcement in the Port Washington Public Parking District; and

WHEREAS, Secure Watch24 would not offer live data and will have a lag period between purchase of a parking sticker and the updated database flowing to the ALPR System, which will likely cause erroneous tickets to be issued especially for daily tickets; and

WHEREAS, the Town does not have sufficient information to make the determination that the seamless integration needed for this system will be provided by SecureWatch24; and

WHEREAS, the Acting Commissioner of Public Safety (the "Acting Commissioner") has recommended to this Board that the bid of SecureWatch24 be rejected as not responsible for the reasons stated above; and

WHEREAS, the Acting Commissioner has further recommended that a contract for an ALPR System be awarded to Gtechna USA, 334 Cornelia Street, No. 549, Plattsburgh, New York 12901 (the "Award") as the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to authorize the Award as recommended by the Commissioner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED that the Award as recommended by the Commissioner is hereby authorized; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Supervisor and/or the Commissioner of Administrative Services be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute, on behalf of the Town, any purchase agreements and related documents, a copy of which shall be on file in the Department of Administrative Services, and to take such other related action as may be necessary to effectuate the foregoing; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Comptroller be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to pay the costs of said awards upon receipt of a duly executed and certified claims therefor.
