

Great Neck Water Pollution Control District

RESOLUTION NO. 08-2012

September 6, 2012

Upon motion duly made by Commissioner Lesser, seconded by Commissioner Rebhuhn and unanimously carried, the following resolutions were duly adapted:

RESOLVED, that the next annual election of the Great Neck Water Pollution Control District shall be held on the **11th day of December, 2012** and that the polls be open for the receipt of ballots at such election from three o'clock in the afternoon until nine o'clock in the evening of said day at the following places:

The Great Neck Senior Citizens Center
80 Grace Avenue, Village of Thomaston

E. M. Baker School
69 Baker Hill Road, Village of Great Neck;

and it is further

RESOLVED, that the office to be filled by said election and the term thereof is as follows:

OFFICE - COMMISSIONER

TERM - THREE YEARS; and it is further,

RESOLVED, that pursuant to Town Law Section 215(20), a) all candidates for the office of Commissioner of the District, to be voted for at such election, shall file their names with the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners at District Headquarters located at 236 East Shore Road, Great Neck, New York at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of such District election and no later than the close of the business day on **November 9, 2012** and, b) such nominations shall be submitted in petition form subscribed by twenty-five (25) registered voters of the District; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the use of voting machines approved by the Secretary of State in accordance with Article 9 of the Election Law of the State of New York is hereby authorized; and it is

RESOLVED, that no person shall be entitled to vote at such election unless he or she is a registered voter with the Nassau County Board of Elections, who shall have resided in said Great Neck Water Pollution Control District for a period of thirty (30) days next preceding such election: and it is further

RESOLVED, that only those persons who are registered with the Nassau County Board of Elections on or before the 23rd day prior to the date of such election shall be entitled to vote at such election, and it is further

RESOLVED, that qualified voters of the Great Neck Water Pollution Control District may vote at either of the aforesaid polling places; and be it further

RESOLVED, that absentee ballots will be available pursuant to Town Law §213-b.

The Board directed that the election notice be forwarded to the Great Neck Record and the Great Neck News for publication.
