

**PUBLIC NOTICE**

**PORT WASHINGTON WATER POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT**

BE IT RESOLVED that pursuant to Article 13, Section 212 of the Town Law, an election of the Port Washington Water Pollution Control District will be held at the Polish American Citizens Association Building, 5 Pulaski Place, Port Washington, New York, on **December 14, 2010** between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. for the purpose of electing one Commissioner for a term of three (3) years beginning on **January 1, 2011** and ending on **December 31, 2013**, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following persons shall be entitled to vote for Commissioner at the aforesaid election: a person who shall have been registered to vote with the Nassau County Board of Elections and whose name has been placed on the District's Register pursuant to Section 213-a of the Town Law and who shall have resided in the Port Washington Water Pollution Control District for at least thirty (30) days next preceding said election to be held on **December 14, 2010**, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to Section 215(20) of the Town Law, candidates for the office of Commissioner shall file their names and nominations in petition form with the Secretary of the Board of Commissioners of the Port Washington Water Pollution Control District no later than 3:30 p.m. on or before **November 12, 2010** and that such nominating petitions must be subscribed by at least twenty-five (25) registered voters of the Port Washington Water Pollution Control District, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a legal notice to the registered voters and residents of the Port Washington Water Pollution Control District setting forth this Resolution be published one time in the official newspapers of the Port Washington Water Pollution Control District.
