Carol Frank was appointed in January 2014 to represent the Town of North Hempstead on the Board of the Water Authority of Great Neck North.

Frank was a investigative journalist for Anton Publications for 14 years, specializing in writing about a wide range of environmental issues. The topics included educating the public about Long Island's aquifers and the need for their protection, how to prevent deadly bird strikes on windows, how humans are negatively affected by light pollution, the overuse of pesticides, controlling feral cat populations, the benefits of backyard chickens and the role red foxes play in keeping down Lyme-disease ticks.

Frank is also a member of the Great Neck Historical Society and is working on the fundraising committee to restore and preserve the Stepping Stones Lighthouse, an important and beautiful maritime treasure.
