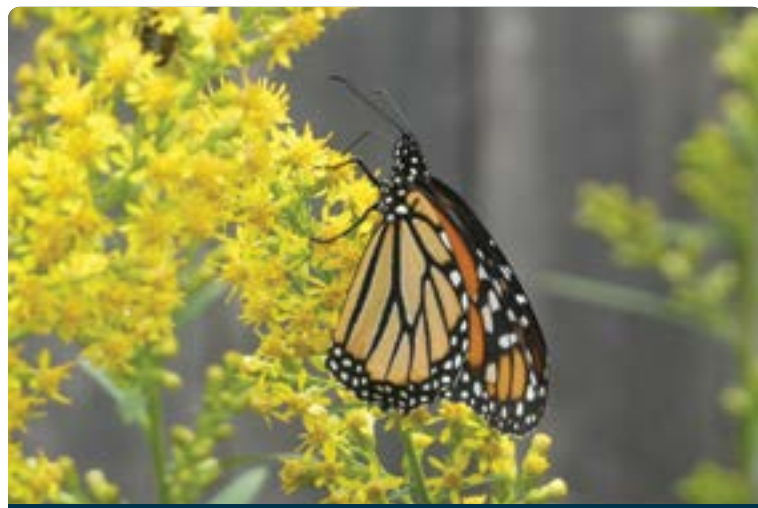

Drop-in Recreation Programs

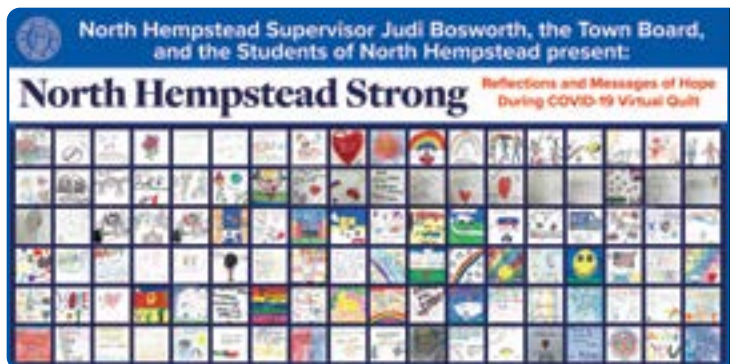
This summer the Town will be offering outdoor drop-in recreation programs including Flow Yoga, Yo Chi, and Cardio Strength at Manorhaven Beach Park in Port Washington, Mary Jane Davies Green in Manhasset, and Michael J. Tully Park in New Hyde Park from May 18 through September 2. Classes are free, advanced registration is not required. Classes are designed for adults and will be limited to 25 participants.
