

Chief Deputy Comptroller position (Promotional)- Current Town of North Hempstead Employees Only

The Town of North Hempstead, a municipality with 222,000 residents, located on the north shore of Long Island in Nassau County, is seeking a Chief Deputy Comptroller. The Chief Deputy Comptroller will currently oversee the day-to-day operations of the Comptroller's Office, including staff management, an array of financial transactions, and long-term financial management and reporting. Key functions include:

- Preparation and filing of the Town's Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR);
- Preparation and filing of annual financial reports with the Office of the NYS Comptroller and other governmental agencies;
- Oversight of required annual audits, including coordination of work with retained audit personnel;
- Accounting and control of the Town's capital accounts, capital assets, and associated records;
- Oversight of cash management for the Town and 19 Town-operated special districts;
- Oversight of claims processing and payroll;
- Implementation of GASB standards, including but not limited to GASB 34 and 45.
- Management and training of staff;
- Frequent interaction with management and staff of other Departments, elected and appointed officials, and other governmental agencies;
- Interaction with Supervisor and senior staff;
- Board meeting representative.

The successful candidate must be a currently Deputy Comptroller and hold an active CPA license; Salary DOQ.
